Both the OMCYA and the services contracted have the option to terminate the arrangement from the end of August 2011 subject to provision of at least 3 months notice. This is a wonderful publication by one of our local practitioners, Máire Uí Bhroin, Stiurthóir of Naíonra Choill Mhic Thomáisín.

## Tráthnóna sa Naíonra

This booklet contains photographs of children playing taken at Naíonra Choill Mhic Thomáisín with simple phrases in Irish, English, Chinese and Polish to acknowledge some of the many languages spoken daily in Ireland today. It came into being when staff at the Naíonra could not source an Irish language book with real photographs of pre-school children involved in activities such as paint, water, sand and playdough based in Ireland-so therefore decided to print their own. The booklet has a total of twenty-five photographs, taken both inside and outside, of young children involved in the usual activities that are common to pre-schools-building, climbing, sweeping, digging, making bubbles, painting, role-playing and so on. The children who are featured in the booklet were in the afternoon group last year and returned to An Naíonra to play together again on the night of the launch. #### Directory of Childcare Services

We have started to implement some of the recommendations of the recently launched Evaluation of the Impact of the National Childminding Initiative on the Quality of Childminding in Waterford City & County. A key recommendation of the report was greater coordination of events and information sharing between the two CCC's. From March an updated Directory of Childcare Services (DoS) will be sent to Waterford City so that any parent who lives in the county, but who contacts the city for a list of childminders can have the widest possible choice of childminders available to them. ## Modeligo Parent & Toddler Group

Every Friday morning at 10.30am - 12pm Modeligo Parent & Toddler Group meet up in the Community Hall. The group has been running since March 2003 and have attracted members from Dungarvan, Cappoquin, Lismore, Villierstown, Tourneena as well as from the Modeligo area. Our members include mums, grandparents, aunties, childminders and a few brave dads.

We have a large hall for the children to play in and have a good selection of toys including a kitchen, a tool bench, many ride on vehicles and slides. When the weather is good we have a safe outside space to play in. The children love the craft corner where they make tremendous "works of art" and make a lovely mess with the Play Doh! For those who like "quieter play" we have a selection of jigsaws and books.

So far this year we have held a Cheerios Breakfast charity morning, and a Healthy Eating Training morning where the adults learnt about healthy meals and everyone sampled a huge range of fruit & veg and healthy snacks. The highlight so far this year was a trip to the Fire Station in Dungarvan. Fire Fighter Pat showed the children and adults around the fire station and the children were able to try on the helmets and play in the Fire Engines. The children loved the flashing lights but weren't too keen on the sirens!

Every year we hold Halloween, Christmas, Easter and Summer parties for the children where the children enjoy party games, party food and dancing.

This year we plan to arrange Paediatric First Aid training for the adults and activity mornings for the children. Modeligo Parent & Toddler is a great place for adults to meet. Many local members and those who have moved into the area from across Ireland and abroad have established great and lasting friendships through the group.

## Reminder re Training

As you are aware staff from WCCC visited your premise recently and included in the visit was a questionnaire to identify training that you might need in 2011. We would advise that you look regularly at our website and our monthly training calendars to see when training is available. Occupational First Aid Certificates must be updated every 2 years and within 90 days of expiry date on the certificate. Primary Food Hygiene certificates must be updated every 5 years. Note: The next Refresher Occupational First Aid is on the 12th March, places are limited. The Primary Food Hygiene course which is being delivered over 3 nights will commence on the 14th March.
